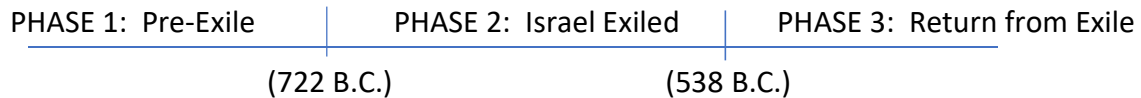


## WEEK 2: Prophet Amos

	JOEL (recap)	AMOS
<b>WHEN:</b>	<p>???</p> <p>date unknown</p>	<p>Phase 1</p> <p>(1:1) King <u>UZZIAH</u> of Judah: <b>RIGHT (2 Ki. 15:3)</b></p> <p>King <u>JEROBOAM</u> of Israel: <b>EVIL (2 Ki. 14:24)</b></p>
<b>WHO:</b>	<p>???</p> <p>prophet unknown</p>	<p>(1:1) <b>shepherd</b></p> <p>(7:10-17) <b>not prophet / son of prophet</b> <b>Herdsman, dress of sycamore figs (poor man)</b></p>
<b>WHAT SIN:</b>	<p>???</p> <p>particular sins unnamed</p>	<p>(2:6-16) <b>Sold the needy, trample the poor, turn aside afflicted, With same girl, keep garments of pledge, drink wine of fined</b></p> <p>(6:1-8) <b>At ease, feel secure, lie on ivory beds/couches, Eat of flocks/calves, sing idle songs, invent instruments, Drink wine, anoint with fine oils, not grieved over ruin, Revelry, stretched out, pride</b></p> <p>(8:4-6) <b>Trample needy, bring the poor to end, deal deceitfully, buy the poor/needy, sell chaff, pride</b></p>
