[CONTEXT: "Phase 2" and Assyria]

2 Kings 18:9-12 Major Event: <u>Assyria exiles Israel</u>

2 Kings 18:13-17 Major Event: <u>Assyria threatens Judah</u>

2 Kings 19:20-28 Major Event: <u>Response to Judah's prayer</u>

2 Kings 19:32-37 Major Event: <u>Assyria turned away</u>

[READ: Nahum 3:1-7]

"The bloody city" (v. 1): Nineveh (v. 7, 1:1), capital of Assyria

Nahum foretells "Battle of Nineveh": Invasion/ruin of Nineveh (c. 612 B.C.)



[THINK]

Q: **To whom** is the prophecy of Nahum written? (ABOUT Nineveh, but TO Judah)

Q: Why was the prophecy of Nahum written?

JONAH	NAHUM (Jonah sequel)
Nineveh to be destroyed	Nineveh to be destroyed
Nineveh repents	(No recorded response from Nineveh)
LORD has mercy	LORD has wrath
God's people are REBUKED	God's People are COMFORTED (Nahum 1:15)

Book's impact on God's people:

The name "Nahum" means <u>COMFORT</u> . (See Nahum 3:7)

Q: How are we to view the LORD's vengeance (Nahum 1:2)?

(See Romans 12:14-21)
