



- **4.1** "'I have loved you,' says the Lord. But you say, 'How have you loved us?'" (Malachi 1:2)
- **4.2** "Take away from me the noise of your songs; to the melody of your harps I will not listen.

  But let justice roll down like waters, and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream." (Amos 5:23f)
