Q1: Are science and faith incompatible? No.

Many of the history's greatest scientists were also Christians or people of faith:

Roger Bacon & William of Ockham (Founders of scientific method); Robert Boyle ("Boyle's Law" of gases); Galileo Galilei
(Observational astronomy) Isaac Newton ("Newton's Laws" of motion); Michael Faraday ("Faraday's Law" of induction); James
Clerk Maxwell ("Maxwell's Equations" of electromagnetism); Lord Kelvin (Kelvin temperature scale); Gregor Mendel (Genetics)

Q2: How should we handle disagreements between our best current science and the Bible?

Psalm 19 Romans 1:18-22

GENERAL REVELATION	
SPECIAL REVELATION	

"We know him [God] by two means:

"First, by the creation, preservation, and government of the universe, since that <u>universe</u> is before our eyes like a beautiful book in which all creatures, great and small, are as letters to make us ponder the invisible things of God: his eternal power and his divinity, as the apostle Paul says in Romans 1:20. All these things are enough to convict men and to leave them without excuse.

"Second, he makes himself known to us more openly by his holy and <u>divine Word</u>, as much as we need in this life, for his glory and for the salvation of his own."

-Belgic Confession (1561), Article 2

Since both are revelations from God, they will never be in *actual* contradiction to each other. (If science and the Bible *appear* to contradict, someone must be wrong!)

POTENTIAL ERRORS related to SCIENCE

- ✓ New discoveries × Co
- ✓ Insufficient data
- ✓ Misinterpretation of data

POTENTIAL ERRORS related to the BIBLE

- Complete, with no newly added "revelations"
- √ (Bible doesn't address everything in the universe)
- √ (Bible is never wrong, but may be misinterpreted)

TAKEAWAYS:

- Science and the Bible are never in actual conflict; both are sources of God's revelation to us.
- The Bible is never wrong, but it may be wrongly interpreted and there corrected by science.
- Our highest loyalty is to the Bible as ultimate truth, which can correct some scientific errors.
